Introduction:

If one wants to be excellent in the field of printing, his horoscope should have Gemini, its lord Mercury, third house and third house lord, Aquarius, its lord Saturn, 11th house and 11th house lord are all strong. Why here we taking Gemini as its lord Mercury and Aquarius as its lord Saturn? According to the Kalapurusha philosophy, the third house is the bava which refers to all works related to writing. According to kalapurusha tattva this Bava is called Mithunam. Its lord is Mercury, and education's karaka butan here. The work of the third bava's are education, writing related, deed recording related, computer related, education related, accounting related, all these are related to numbers and words. We take this 3rd Bava and its lord Mercury for this study because there are more karakas related to numbers and words than other planets.

A Scientific View of Mercury:

Mercury is the closest planet to the Sun. It is also the smallest planet in the solar system. It takes 88 days to go around the sun once. Seen from Earth it appears to take 116 days. No natural moons are known for it. The planet is named after the Roman messenger god 'Mercury' in Western culture. 'Budhan' is the cause of knowledge in Indian culture; Named after God. Because Mercury's angular separation from the Sun is low (at most only 28.3°), Mercury is rare to see, mostly due to the brightness of the Sun. Our ancestors say, even if our witnesses get kshabon they don't get Mercury'. Morning or evening twilight is the perfect time to see Mercury. Because Mercury lacks an atmosphere to retain heat from the Sun, Mercury's surface experiences greater temperature fluctuations than any other planet. Near the equator it is 700 m (427 °F; 800 °C) during the day and 100 m (-173 °F; -280 °C) at night. It is always coldest at the terminals (poles) below 180 M (-93 °F; -136 °C). Mercury's axis has the lowest inclination (about 1/30 degree) in the Solar System. But its orbital deviation is very high. Mercury is almost similar in appearance to Earth's moon. It is characterized by many large pits (craters) with a cut space. Like Earth, Mercury has no atmosphere. But unlike Earth, it doesn't have seasons like most other planets. Mercury has a metal as large as iron. Due to this, Mercury also has some magnetic field. When we look at the statement in this science, it is known that there are iron ores in the planet Mercury. Saturn is the ruler of iron. So we know that there is a similarity in nature between Mercury and Saturn.

A Scientific View of Saturn:

Saturn is the sixth planet from the Sun and the second-largest in the Solar System, after Jupiter. It is a gas giant with an average radius of about nine-and-a-half times that of Earth. It has only one-eighth the average density of Earth, but is over 95 times more massive. Even though Saturn is nearly the size of Jupiter, Saturn has less than one-third of Jupiter's mass. Saturn orbits the Sun at a distance of 9.59 AU (1,434 million km) with an orbital period of 29.45 years. Saturn's interior is thought to be composed of a rocky core, surrounded by a deep layer of metallic hydrogen, an intermediate layer of liquid hydrogen and liquid helium, and finally, a gaseous outer layer. Saturn has a pale yellow hue due to ammonia crystals in its upper atmosphere. An electrical current within the metallic hydrogen layer is thought to give rise to Saturn's planetary magnetic field, which is weaker than Earth's, but which has a magnetic moment 580 times that of Earth due to Saturn's larger size. Saturn's magnetic field strength is around one-twentieth of Jupiter's. The outer atmosphere is generally bland and lacking in contrast, although long-lived features can appear. Wind speeds on Saturn can reach 1,800 kilometres per hour (1,100 miles per hour).

The planet has a bright and extensive ring system composed mainly of ice particles, with a smaller amount of rocky debris and dust. At least 146 moons are known to orbit the planet, of which 63 are officially named; this does not include the hundreds of moonlets in its rings. Titan, Saturn's largest moon and the second largest in the Solar System, is larger (while less massive) than the planet Mercury and is the only moon in the Solar System to have a substantial atmosphere. Saturn is named after the Roman god of wealth and agriculture and father of Jupiter. Its astronomical symbol (♄) has been traced back to the Greek Oxyrhynchus Papyri, where it can be seen to be a Greek kappa-rho ligature with a horizontal stroke, as an abbreviation for *Κρόνος* (Cronus), the Greek name for the planet. It later came to look like a lower-case Greek eta, with the cross added at the top in the 16th century to Christianize this pagan symbol. The Romans named the seventh day of the week Saturday, *Sāturni diēs* ("Saturn's Day"), for the planet Saturn.

Let's See the Characters of 12 Houses:

1st House Characters:

Denoting the head, denoting the brain in the head, denoting one's unique talent, leaders, possessing leadership qualities, talented, honorable, self-knowledgeable, yoga to experience anything, success or failure, immunity in the body, sense of self,

money. Emphasis on prestige, thought processes, self-efforts efficiency, health, generosity, administrative ability, discipline, ability to achieve in a field.

2nd House Characters:

Second house refers to the facial organs like eyes, nose, mouth, tongue, teeth, jaw, chin, throat etc. Ability to speak to explain one's own opinion, structure of consuming delicious food, structure of face, vision, cash flow, wealth, easily convertible objects, yoga for enjoying one's wealth, easily convertible objects like grains, metals, gems, jewelry, gold, silver and add family members, All education comes under second house.

3rd House Characters:

Ear, shoulder, hands, neck, nervous system in the body below the neck, blood vessels, sense organs, Third house means writing, so all kinds of communication, exchange of information, contracts, shoulder hands, Vijaya, Viriyam, Courage, Confidence, Fortitude, Determination, Perseverance, Little Trips, Little Success, Post Offices, Telephone, Radio, News, Shrinking Anything, Badges, Certificates, Cheques, All Records in the World, Messengers, Journalism, advertising, library, printing, printing industry, leasing, rumours, confusion, brain washing comes under third house.

4th House Characters:

4th house, Estate, vehicle, mother, one's comfort, one's immovable property, movable property, lungs, heart, all similar productive activities, education, land, grain fields, farms, buildings, memorials, antiques, fixed objects, producing the same kind of m/c, primary school, treasures, mines, household goods, surplus money, ancestral property, well, river, lake, grave comes under 4th house.

5th House Characters:

Love, physical attractiveness, commentary, beauty, intelligent thinking, physical morals, memorization, raw materials, origin, intelligence, power to create a life, entertainment, beautification, frolic, taste, interest in art, Lack of physical work, deep thinking, excessive indulgence in sensuality, business like commission, calculation of the number of one's children, sports etc.

6th House Characters:

This is the Bhava of the Stomach; it is a Bhava that refers to the bile inside the stomach, the liver and diseases related to these. Work for wages, understanding of work in others, labourers, enmity, litigation, avarice, greed, arrogance, boasting, usurpation of another's property, doing better than others, temporary credit or debt, solitude, prison, lonely life, neglect by others.

7th House Characters:

Married life, life partner details, people with a lot of public relations, no one likes to look good in front of the crowd, public support, public meeting, details of theft, hostile touch, pleasant exchanges, long-term habits with others, Business, partners in business, alliances, open character of Jataka, tendency to involve others in anything, second child, respect for other people's opinions, dependence on others are the Karakas of Seventh house.

8th House Characters:

In the anatomy, the eighth house represents the mysterious organs, the eighth house determines the extent of the Jataka's life, i.e. life span and the environment in which death takes place. Negative events such as pain, agony, betrayal, grief, misfortune, struggle, accident, repair of body parts, theft of the horoscope's property by others, illegal actions of the horoscope, cross paths, etc., which bring harm to the ascendant, are the karakas of the eighth house. Also suicide, murder, mutilation of body parts, robbery, harassment by enemies, all kinds of obstacles, waste, loss, insurance, life inheritance, charity, bribery, money of the deceased, surgery, heavy debt beyond the power of the horoscope, low self-esteem and hard work, all at the same time. Many types of diseases, chronic diseases, diseases that cause great pain and suffering, illegal substances, excessive anger, loss of father at a young age, natural disasters, all kinds of unexpected good and bad events that a Jataka never dreamed of.

9th House Characters:

In physical aspect, the ninth Bhavakam representing the pelvic girdle, anus, etc. is trigona Bhavakam for Lagna Bhava, so it makes the karakas of Lagna Bhavaka flourish in a very noble position. Charakas that enhance the Jataka's personality, such as Godliness, Inference, Worship, Research, Honesty, Faith, Charity, High Thoughts, Humanity, Research, Intuition, Religious Belief, Acquiring Anything easily will differentiate one from others to a great extent. Our forefathers also called this as bagyasthan as the Ninth Bhavakam determines the fortune of the Jataka due to past deeds or the deeds of the Jataka in previous births. One of the main reasons is the system of giving a lot of respect to others due to one's actions, being very rich and donating a lot of wealth from others, lotteries, stock market, as fortunes such as the Ninth house of Bhavakam. Deep sleep, meditation, receiving instruction from Guru, meeting spiritualists, traditional thoughts, not leaving, deity works etc., the mind of the Jataka will go to non-economical things when the ninth house is running, and since the ninth house is trigon before lagna, it represents father in relationship and ancestors after father. . Generosity, Forethought, Long Distance Travel, Pilgrimage, Sea Travel, Air Travel, Abroad, Strangers, Higher Education, Universities, Nature Deities, Temple, Church, Mosque, Deity, Worshipful Persons, Guru, Foreign News, Long Distance News , radio, television, wireless telegraphy, spirit world communications, world experiences, law and order, judiciary, justice, legal arbitrator, export-import, international trade, inheritance, Freezing of money, loss of business, and the benefits and harms of past signs are the causes of the ninth house.

10th House Characters:

In the body element, the tenth Bhava represents the thighs, the organs that are always producing and functioning, such as the kidneys, liver, intestines, etc. A person's status, fame, recognition etc. are measured by the profession he does. 10th Bhavakam is the endowment of business when wealth is gained through economic activity. Self-earning of economy through business gives one status. A permanent job gives a person financial security. Kendras are stronger than each other just as triangles are stronger than each other, so the strongest of Kendras is the tenth house. 10th Bhavakam is an important Bhavakam in Bhava math calculation. This bhavakam is called the apex or peak of the horoscope. The 10th house indicates all the professions in the world, no matter what profession or job one is in, the 10th house plays an important role in achieving professional status, the tenth house must be strengthened in order for one to stay in the big positions in the business. Livelihood Earned by profession Social status, managerial ability, awareness and responsibility in anything, duty, authority, karmic rite for parents, unsatisfied attitude in

anything, reward from government, property of spouse, danger to younger brother, waste to elder brother, presiding over associational meetings, adopted child, Details of spouse's mother, mother-in-law, child's illness, always producing a product etc. are the factors of Tenth Bhavaka.

11th House Characters:

In anatomy eleventh house represents knees, joints and vitamins in the body, the eleventh house can tell if one is easily satisfied i.e. has the attitude of having enough. Success, net worth, profit, saving money without investing in anything, always being active and happy, discovering unknown secrets and gaining siddhi, being lively and happy with others, spending within the means and saving, progressing without obstacles in everything are the karakas of 11th house. The eleventh sign represents our long-term friends and well-wishers who are close to us. 11th Bhavakam is to collect a loan from someone in full. In Prasanna Astrology the eleventh sign plays an important role, especially whether one's desires are fulfilled or not. It can be known only through the 11th Bhavaka. The eleventh house refers to an elder brother or sister. It also indicates life partners of the horoscope's children i.e. son-in-law - daughter-in-law. Also one's desire, aspirations, goal, achievements, immunity in the body, vitamins, close friends of the horoscope, well-wishers of the horoscope, flatterers of the horoscope, saving habits, planning of efforts, satisfaction after fulfillment of desires, lasting friendship, group of like-minded people, Sangam meeting, conference, supreme education, full knowledge, thorough study in a field and getting doctor degree Ph.D., intelligence, parliament, legislature, municipalities, recovery from illness, return home from hospital etc.

12th House Characters:

In the body, the 12th bhava represents evils and waste products from the body. The 12th Bhavakam is the Bhavakam which ends all the functions of the Lagna horoscope. Our forefathers said that the 12th bhavakam is the place of moksha end because it shows the complete liberation of the horoscope from the cycle of birth and death and merges with the universe and nature. Ascendant means appearance and the 12th house can be said to be hidden or concealed, i.e. secret. So secret conspiracies, secret plans, conspiracies, secret enemies, murders for political reasons, unsolved riddles, hidden things, detective work, secret investments etc. are the causes of 12th house. 12th Bhavakam Dysfunction of body parts and brain Low attitude of the Jataka towards himself Being isolated without company of others Jataka not involved in anything, failure living in hiding, being kept away by social restrictions, prisons, orphanages, all kinds of hindrances, losses, excess expenses to the Jataka, excessive Repayment of loans with interest, inability to overcome hidden objections, secret imprisonment, hospital treatment, all kinds of punishments and fines, and renunciation of everything. At the same time 12th Bhavakam transfers, goes abroad, lives in a completely new situation, acquires citizenship abroad, invests money in property etc., gives one's job to someone else and is at ease, takes up a second career, establishes successive branches of business, finishes all work and goes to bed, Sleep also has the power to discover new things.

Types of Industries:

Industries are divided into two categories. One is intrinsically oriented industries and the second is extrinsically oriented industries. Here internal signs are 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11 which are internal signs. External signs are 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12 which are external signs. The printing department is only good if it has these two signs i.e. internal and external, because if we have to express the thoughts that have appeared internally, if we want to write, it needs some tools like writing, and for that we have to take it from the external signs. All the tools and machinery used for printing are dependent on the outside. So if the printing industry wants to succeed, it needs machines. Iron, the raw material for machines, is an element dominated by Saturn. If we want to melt that iron, we can use the fiery planet Mars to melt that iron and make machines. Therefore Saturn, the ruler of iron and Mars, the cause of fire, can have both the planets, according to Kala Purusha philosophy, the tenth house sign is Makara Rasi. This Makara Rasi is ruled by Saturn, the Avita Nakshatra that can be in that sign, it is a star with Mars, so the tenth house is an external house, so it is only ten if the axis has internal signs, and only if there is a partner with external signs, this axis will be better. Objective in the study.

2nd bhavaka is speech, conversing, all actions done through our mouth are 2nd bhavaka. It is a peripheral behavior. If we leave the words, speech, and ideas that we have come up with as they are through this extraneous behavior, there is a chance that it will be destroyed in the course of time. That's why we have to embed these. The only equipment required for this is the mold. The 3rd Bhavakam is the Bhavakam corresponding to that axis. The 3rd Bhavaka is an evolutionary development of the 1st Bhavaka. That is, it is this 3rd Bhavaka that appears in the 1st Bhavakam and forms the thought, the letter. It was apparently created as a form of writing that could be used for all time, with the secondary use of external speech. It is timeless and created in a color that everyone can easily use. Therefore, this third house is also considered very important for the printing industry. Those who are good at the third house have more chances to excel in this printing industry. And through this we can know the necessity of Mercury in printing field. Man's nature, The bhavakam which can be called career is the 10th house. According to Kala purusha Tattva the third house is Gemini with Mercury as its lord, and the tenth house is Capricorn with Saturn as its lord. Therefore, when we think that a person should do well, in his horoscope, third house, Gemini, Mercury and Aquarius, Saturn should not be in 8th and 12th house for any reason. That means in your horoscope if Mercury and Saturn are in his Lagna 8, 12 Bhavas he will not be good in his printing business field.

 - Eleventh house Cancer is in Virgo with its lord Moon in Lagna. It is a Mercury house. So the eleventh house is also good.
 - 10th Bhavagam Gemini with its lord Mercury in Ascendant in trigonal bava, fifth sign Capricorn is a specialty.
 - Virgo Lagna is in Capricorn, the fifth house from its lord Mercury Lagna.
 - Both Mercury and Saturn are in kendra and trigona bhavas in this horoscope i.e. Mercury is in trigon and Saturn is in kendra house.
 - Third house lord Mars is the essence of Anusham Third pada This is the essence of Saturn.

All the thoughts that arise in the First Bhavaka are perfected in the Third Bhavaka, which is the evolution of the First Bhavaka. Through this study we can know that it is a very important practice to improve the society.
